this is a particularly small cephalopod species, the bobtail cuttlefish only measures 5 cm, male specimens are even smaller, they are only 3 cm long. the body is translucent and covered with numerous dark brown chromatophores. they usually live on the seabed, half buried in the bottom and covered with sand, perfectly camouflaged. bobtail cuttlefish are able to produce bioluminescence with special photophores close to their inc sac. they use their light organs during the night when approaching their prey, little crustaceans.
