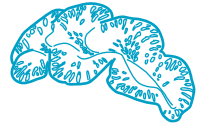

like the other members of the tridacnidae family the fluted giant clam is host to symbiotic photosynthesizing organisms called zooxanthellae which live in the mantle of the giant clam. this particular species attaches itself to the substrate and does not bore into coral heads, like the bigger tridacna crocea does.

the scientific name derives from the latin name for scale, hinting to the numerous rows of scale-like structures on its shell as does the common name 'fluted', which alludes to the large channelled surface in the same way.
