the latin name frondosa refers to the 'sprouting' appendices that give the weedy scorpionfish its distinct look. the fins are incised and appear somewhat frayed. this species comes in various colorations, red and dark purple are as common as yellow and pale lilac, the skin is covered in pale spots and darker blotches that perfect the camouflage further. divers have observed, that the weedy scorpionfish sways its body from side to side, to give the impression of seaweed in the groundswell.

like other members of the family of scorpaenidae the weedy scorpionfish creates a vacuum with its mouth, sucking in any prey literally in a wink of an eye.
