the pincushion urchin is a compact species with a striking coloration. its spines are short and usually red or orange-brown in color, 10 bare sections without spines show a bright blue or black color. the pincushion urchin feeds on algae and grazes the seabed during the night. during the day it hides in crevices or near rocks. sometimes the pincushion urchin disguises itself with pieces of sponges, algae and little shells that get caught in the spikey areas of its body.
