this species lives in the open see (pelagic) and settles on the seabed of coastal coral reefs only for breeding. it appears, that ghostpipefish form monogamous pairs for the reproductive season maybe even lasting for a longer period. unlike the seahorses, where the male nurses the young in a pouch, ghostpipefish possess no pouch. instead the female looks after the eggs in a pouch-like modified pair of fins. ghostpipefish are perfectly camouflaged, they look like seaweed and float in the groundswell. they feed on small crustaceans.
